Dear Paw Creek,

Backpack Buddies for River Oaks Academy News

The 2023/24 year for Backpack Buddies comes to a close with the end of the school term on June5th. This school term, we provided food for 15 students at River Oaks Academy. (Five of the 15 were from the same family.) It may seem simple to provide a meal bag for these students, but it takes a lot of devotion, love, and coordination. Each bag is packed with enough food for @7 meals/snacks. This means that we are putting 16 items in each of the 15 bags for the 32 weeks that we deliver to the students at River Oaks. Over the school term, in total, we have delivered 480 bags, which means 3,360 meals or 7,680 items.

The Presbyterian Women, who sponsor this program, give special thanks to the following devoted volunteers for this program:

Teresa Painter, Belinda & Stan Springs, who packed the bags and kept up with lists for purchase (and sometimes purchased items for packing).

Jan, Carol, Eddie, and Dickie Chapman who also purchase the items for packing and managed the recyclables.
